In 1988, at the age of 16, Oliver Menne started his career as a freelance writer for – at that time – well-known Commodore 64 magazines “Game-On” and “Magic Disk 64”. Shortly after his exams he became Editor of “PC Games” and led it from a circulation of 40,000 in 1993 to 380,000 in 1998. During that time he reviewed hundreds of games for all kinds of

platforms – from Amiga to PC and all console systems in between. In 1999, Oliver Menne joined the Executive Board of Computec Media AG as Chief Editorial Officer, where he launched magazines in the US, UK, France and Scandinavia. In 2006 he left Computec Media to start his own business.

Today he’s Managing Director of Eurogamer.de, a specialist website with editorial content for all current gaming platforms, mainly reviews and previews. Eurogamer.de is part of the ten year old Eurogamer Network. The German site attracts approx. 700,000 Unique Visitors per month.

Eurogamer is published in ten different countries and languages with an audience of approx. 3.7 million unique visitors each month.
